ACTA Secretariat:

The Telecommunications Industry Association (TIA) submits the technical criteria identified above for adoption by the ACTA. In doing so, and pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 68.604, TIA hereby certifies that: (1) the organization is ANSI-accredited and in good standing under the ANSI Essential Requirements and has been during the development of the submitted technical criteria; (2) the submitted technical criteria does not conflict with any ACTA adopted technical criteria or with any technical criteria submitted and pending for publication (as determined through the public process observed in developing the submitted technical criteria); (3) the submitted technical criteria are limited to requirements for connecting equipment to the Public Switched Telephone Network and Advanced Communications Services as identified in § 68.3; and, (4) the criteria were developed in accordance with applicable ANSI requirements.

TIA hereby grants the ACTA Secretariat the right to reproduce, distribute and publish the submitted technical criteria identified above (the “Material”) for the limited purpose of public notification pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 68.608.


