PUBLIC NOTICE
Adjustments to ACTA Filing Fees
August 1, 2012

Washington, D.C. – Effective October 1, 2012 the Administrative Council for Terminal Attachment (ACTA) is adjusting its fee for processing Telephone Terminal Equipment (TTE) information submitted for inclusion in the centralized database of Part 68 equipment from \$650.00 to **\$825.00 per submission**. The adjusted fee applies to submission of Original, Modifications, Notice of Change, Recertification/re-declarations, and Request for Responsible Party Codes.

Additionally, the fee for processing, posting, and maintaining a Responsible Party's Supplier's Declaration of Conformity (SDoC) on the ACTA website will be adjusted from \$650.00 to \$825.00 (per submission).

As a result of the above adjustments, the *Guidelines and Procedures for submittal of information for inclusion in the ACTA database of approved Telephone Terminal Equipment ("TTE")*, Revision 3.9 will be posted to reflect this change.

TTE approved for connection to the PSTN must comply with all applicable rules and regulations of FCC Part 68, and with the applicable technical criteria adopted by ACTA.

Failure to list TTE in the ACTA database of approved TTE is subject to FCC enforcement procedures.

Parties responsible for TTE, whether they obtain their approval from a Telecommunications Certification Body (TCB) or utilize the SDoC process, must submit to the ACTA database administrator all information required by ACTA to inclusion in the centralized database of approved Part 68 products.
