It was noted that no comments or edits were received by ATIS staff and these notes were approved electronically on month day year (seven days after notification of posting was sent to the exploder list).

5 REVIEW OF ACTION ITEMS FROM PREVIOUS MEETINGS

Action Item: In recent correspondence TIA 41.9 provided additional references, outside of Part 68, for FCC rules. TR41.9 notes that some of the terms are not defined in the CFR FCC-68 rules (i.e., definition for "advanced communications services" (ACS) and the terms "interconnected VoIP service" and "non-interconnected VoIP service") which may lead to the need for interpretation or clarification. These terms, however, may be defined in other FCC rules. Scott Lambert (Bureau Veritas) will provide these terms and references to the FCC, asking for clarification of their definitions. Mr. Lambert indicated that he would provide a draft response back to the Executive Committee for review prior to sending to James Szeliga (FCC).

 Mr. Lambert reviewed this Action Item, noting that he had yet to complete the Action Item. Participants reviewed correspondence from TR41.9 (<u>ACTA-E-2019-00006R000</u>) for context.

It was noted that the FCC is trying to protect the user and the environment and ensure HAC compliance for VoIP, IS, and IT. To this end, the equipment codes were updated to add "or to ACS" or "or via ACS". The FCC's definition of ACS is: "Non-interconnected VoIP includes services that enable real-time voice communications that… neither originate nor terminate on the PSTN."

Mr. Lambert indicated that he would follow up on this Action Item prior to the next virtual meeting.

Action Item: Steve Barclay (ATIS) will work with the ACTA Chair and the Executive Committee to discuss coordination of ACTA meetings with the TCB Conference that is held in Baltimore each year (currently scheduled for October).
